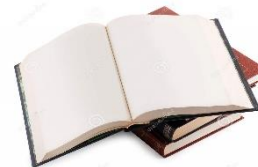

There will be a \$40.50 fee on registration, and thereafter until you become funded. (Children under 12yrs Free & 13yrs – 17yrs \$12.50)



Community Service Cards: will come into play for new patients enrolling with our practice.

If **you have a CSC** - Adults will still pay a one off payment of \$40.50 on enrolment, then all consultations thereafter will be \$18.50 or \$12.50. Children remain the same.

If you **have NO CSC** the cost of \$40.50 will continue until you become funded

Prescriptions: All prescriptions will be charged \$10.00 if you come in and collect.

If you would like to have your prescription faxed to a pharmacy, you will be charged \$15.00

Reminders:

- If you are 7 minutes late for your appointment, you will not be seen, (as this will put the doctors behind time) you will need to reschedule another appointment and you will be charged a \$10.00 penalty fee.
- Late cancellations and DNAs (Did not arrived.) will be charged a \$10.00 penalty fee.
- If your account is \$50.00 or more, you will be asked to pay your account before you have an appointment.
- Automatic Payments are available, please ask the receptionist for a bank form.

Update your community service cards:

The Community Services Card can help you and your family with the costs of health care. Always carry your card to make it easy to get the benefits, like paying less on some health services and prescriptions.

- You don't have to be on a benefit to qualify for the card.
- You can also use the card for your dependent children under 18.
- prescription fees
- fees for after-hours health practitioner visits
- glasses for children under 16
- emergency dental care provided by: hospitals, and approved dental contractors
 - (ask the dental provider if they are an approved contractor)
- travel and accommodation for treatment at a public hospital you've been referred to outside your area:
 - least 80km away for adults
 - = at least 25km for children
- home help.
