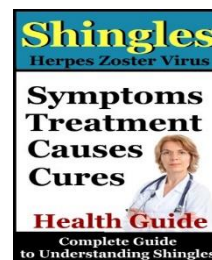


Notices:

- Dr Claire Isham has a new position as Clinical Director at the PHO. This role includes co-ordinating services across the BOP. She is still working at Ngati Kahu Hauora but currently has reduced days. Appointment days are on Monday mornings, (except first Monday of every month on Motiti Island) and Thursday mornings.
- **Appointment Slots:**
When booking appointments, please book accordingly per person, as some patients are taking their families (2 – 4 People) into a one appointment slot which is 15mins. This causes the doctors to run behind time and it is NOT fair to have the other patients wait longer than normal.
- **ACC Appointments:**
Just to clarify – there is still a charge to see the doctor.
ACC pays for any resources the nurse may use ie: cleaning wounds, dressings, sutures toward your injury.

- Adults will need a photo ID.
- Children need a copy of their birth certificate or passport
- There will be a \$40.50 charge on registration for adults and thereafter until you become funded.
- If you have a **community service card** there will be a one off payment of \$40.50, and then you will be charged accordingly. (\$18.50 or \$12.50).

(Children under 12 years are FREE & 13 years – 17 years are \$12.50)
